Note: Diagnostic MSK is considered a separate specialty.

From each **PRACTITIONER** performing US-Guided Interventional Procedures that meets the [USGIP training guideline](#), submit:

- 1 ultrasound-guided interventional procedure case study with its corresponding final report, **and**

From each **SITE** performing US-Guided Interventional Procedures, submit:

Refer to [diagnostic MSK case submission requirements](#) for exam details.

- 1 diagnostic comprehensive joint exam with corresponding final report
(this case is already satisfied by any site also applying in the separate specialty "MSK-Diagnostic")
- and**
- 1 diagnostic limited "joint-region" exam with corresponding final report
(this case is already satisfied by any site also applying in the separate specialty "MSK-Diagnostic")

All cases must follow the **General Requirements for the Submission of Case Studies:**

Note:

Cases must follow the AIUM Practice Parameter for [Selected Ultrasound-Guided Procedures](#).

The final report must include all documentation as outlined in section **V. Reporting of Ultrasound Guided Procedures (pages 3-4)** of the [AIUM Practice Parameter for Documentation of an Ultrasound Examination](#).

For the purpose of accreditation, each USGIP case:

- must consist of labeled images for **PRE** injection, **DURING** injection (**labeled image of needle tip/shaft required**), and **POST** injection with a corresponding final report
- all images must be appropriately labeled with **injection site and relevant side**
- refer to page 2 for a detailed imaging checklist and **SAMPLE REPORT / IMAGES**; note that the sample images include extra labeling to help identify the anatomy (not required for submission)

Report must include all documentation as outlined in section V. Reporting of Ultrasound-Guided Procedures (pages 3-4) of the AIUM Practice Parameter for Documentation of an Ultrasound Examination: http://www.aium.org/resources/guidelines/documentation.pdf
<i>Procedure:</i>
1. All images must show date of procedure
2. Labeled image of procedure site PRE injection ← click for sample
3. Labeled image(s) of procedure site DURING injection : ← click for sample <ul style="list-style-type: none">• in-plane injections (encouraged) - needle shaft and tip must be seen and labeled• if out-of-plane injections are submitted, the needle tip must be labeled for clarity
4. Image of needle is consistent with the description in the report
5. Labeled image of procedure site POST injection : ← click for sample <ul style="list-style-type: none">• post injection image must demonstrate injectate in the correct location (i.e. joint distention, fluid in the target structure, etc.)
